**Favorite Memory:** Haven't had it yet, waiting until May 22.



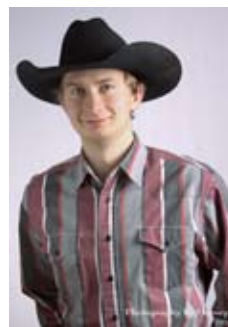

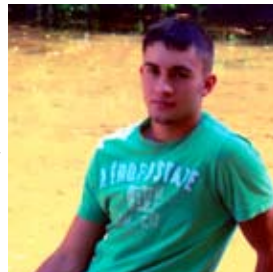

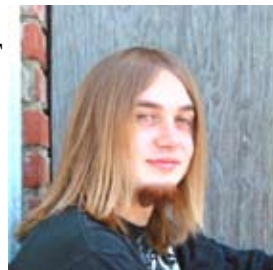
